



Terms & Conditions (28 June 2017)

Below you will find the terms and conditions for entering The Ocean Awards 2018 ("OA"), which are administered by Boat International Media Limited ("BIM"). Please make sure you have read these before submitting an entry to the OA as by submitting a competition entry you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Terms & Conditions for Entering

Eligibility

1. The OA are open to all individuals or projects that have made contributions to the health of the oceans between 1 July 2016 and 30 November 2017. Individuals or projects not active within the specified time period are not eligible.
2. For the purpose of the OA, "categories" are described as on the OA website.
3. The competition is only open to all persons aged 18 years or over, except:
 - a. employees of BIM or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - b. members of the immediate families or households of (a).
4. The decisions on whether the eligibility requirements for the OA are met will be made by BIM and will be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into by BIM.

Entry

5. Persons completing entries to the OA ("Entrants") agree to be bound by, and comply with, these Terms and Conditions and the "Nominations", "Categories" and nomination form sections of the OA website at [<http://www.boatinternational.com/luxury-yacht-events/ocean-awards>] (the "OA website").
6. The nomination period for entries will be open between 28 June 2017 and 30 November 2017. OA entries must be made via the nominations form of the OA website. All OA entry supporting documents must be submitted to BIM via email by Thursday 30 November 2017 at 23:59. BIM reserves the right to disqualify those entries (including supporting documents) which are not received in full by the above time.
7. OA entries will be confirmed by BIM once the completed nomination form(s) are received and accepted by BIM (which shall be at BIM's sole discretion).
8. OA entries may be withdrawn.
9. Entrants are permitted to enter more than one category of the OA but each entrant may only be entered once in each category.
10. OA entries will be judged in accordance with the "Judging Process" section of the OA website. The judges' decisions are final, and no judge will enter into conversation or correspondence concerning decisions that have been made.

Ownership of entries and publicity

11. By submitting an entry, each Entrant agrees that he or she has permission to provide all information, documents and accompanying materials included within that entry without breaching any duty of confidentiality owed to any third party (including, without limitation, the nominee) and that BIM's use of such information, documents and materials in accordance with these terms and conditions shall not infringe the rights (including intellectual property rights) of any third party.

12. Each Entrant agrees that BIM may, but is not required, to make details of their entry (including, without limitation, information, specifications and descriptions relating to the nominee contained in the entry) available on:

- a. promotional material and news reporting relating to the OA;
- b. the OA website; and

and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the OA. By submitting their entry, each Entrant agrees to grant BIM a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, for the full period of any intellectual property rights in the OA entry and any accompanying materials, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sub-licence the OA entry and any accompanying materials for such purpose and warrants that it has the absolute right to grant such licence to BIM.

13. Further to #12, each Entrant agrees that any personal information provided to BIM in connection with his or her entry may be held and used by BIM or its agents and suppliers to administer the OA.

Judging

14. The winner of each category will be announced as part of an editorial piece in BOAT Magazine. There will be no prior disclosure.

15. BIM has the right to determine the standard of an Award and to withhold an Award in any category if, in their view, entries are not of sufficient merit.

16. Each Entrant agrees that if they win the OA, BIM may use his or her name, image and town or country of residence to announce the winner of the OA and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.

17. BIM reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the OA where it becomes necessary to do so.

Limitation of liability

18. To the fullest extent allowed by law and insofar as it is reasonable to do so, entrants to the OA agree not to hold BIM liable for any damage or loss suffered or incurred in connection with entering the OA, including consequential (i.e. losses which are not incurred as a direct consequence of the event leading to any claim) or indirect losses or loss of profit, through entering the OA, alteration of the OA schedule, cancellation of the OA, or any error or omission on the part of BIM.

General

19. If there is any reason to believe that an Entrant has breached these terms and conditions, BIM may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude that Entrant from participating in the OA.

20. These Terms and Conditions, together with the material listed at #4 above, constitute the entire agreement of BIM and those participating in the OA. In submitting an entry and agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions, the parties have not relied on, and shall have no remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, warranty, understanding, promise or assurance (whether negligently or innocently made) of any person other than as expressly set out in these terms and conditions.

21. These terms and conditions are governed by and shall be interpreted in accordance with English law. Any disputes arising in relation to the interpretation of these terms and conditions or in relation to any agreement of which these terms and conditions form part, which cannot be settled amicably, shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
