### **Morning Race Day Update (SI 7.2) Tuesday, 13 June / Race #1**

We have some encouraging weather forecasts for today's racing. The race committee will proceed to the starting area with the intent of being on station by 1000. We will broadcast the Signal Boat location when anchored.

The race committee's intention is to start the racing as scheduled this morning, with a warning signal for the J Class at 1130.

In Notice No. 2 (Scheduled Starting Sequence), delete and replace "Race#2" with "Race #1".

Your attention is directed to Notice No. 3 with the telephone numbers for the RRS-Safety Afterguard Members and Communications Officers (SI 22.3).

The Marion-Bermuda Race boats are out of play today (145nm out with leaders going 6kts as of 0730). The obstruction detailed in SI 21.6.3 and Exhibit 9 is still in effect.

Competitors are reminded that the race committee can set different 'W' marks for different classes. This information will be posted on the Signal Boat for each class and broadcast on the race committee channel.

The first broadcast from the race committee will be at 1000 on VHF 69 with a follow-on broadcast at 1030.
