



Terms & Conditions 3 October 2016

Below you will find the terms and conditions for entering the Young Designer of the Year 2017 (“YDOY”), which are administered by Boat International Media Limited (“BIM”). Please make sure you have read these before submitting an entry to the YDOY as by submitting a competition entry you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Terms & Conditions for Entering

Eligibility

1. For the purpose of the YDOY, YDOY “classes” are described as “Student Designer” and “Full-Time/ “Trainee Designer”.
 - a. For the purpose of the YDOY a “Student Designer” is a designer who is enrolled in full-time or part time studies, who have on no occasion been in paid employment in yacht design. This category will also include those who have graduated and not taken employment in the yachting industry.
 - b. For the purpose of the YDOY a “Full-Time Designer”/ “Trainee Designer” is a designer who has completed their studies who are or have been in paid employment within the yachting industry.
2. The competition is only open to all persons 25 years or less on the 1 January 2017, except:
 - a. employees of BIM or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - b. employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with YDOY or its administration; or
 - c. members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
3. The decisions on whether the eligibility requirements for the YDOY are met will be made by BIM and will be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into by BIM.

Entry

4. Persons completing entries to the YDOY (“Entrants”) agree to be bound by, and comply with, these Terms and Conditions and the “Register”, “Task” and how to enter sections of the YDOY website at [<http://www.boatinternational.com/luxury-yacht-events/showboats-design-awards/young-designer-of-the-year-award-2017--30591>] (the “YDOY website”).
5. The registration period for entries will be open between 9 June 2016 and 30 November 2016. YDOY entries must be made via the registration form of the YDOY website. All YDOY entry supporting documents must be submitted to BIM via email by Wednesday 30 November 2016 at 11:59pm. BIM reserves the right to disqualify those entries (including supporting documents) which are not received in full by the above time.
6. YDOY entries will be confirmed by BIM once the completed registration form(s) are received and accepted by BIM (which shall be at BIM’s sole discretion).
7. YDOY entries may be withdrawn
8. YDOY entries will be judged in accordance with the “Judging Process” section of the YDOY website. The judges’ decisions are final, and no judge will enter into conversation or correspondence concerning decisions that have been made.



Ownership of entries and publicity

9. By submitting an entry, each Entrant agrees that he or she has permission to provide all information, documents and accompanying materials included within that entry without breaching any duty of confidentiality owed to any third party) and that BIM's use of such information, documents and materials in accordance with these terms and conditions shall not infringe the rights (including intellectual property rights) of any third party.
10. Each Entrant agrees that BIM may, but is not required to make details of their entry available on:
 - a. promotional material and news reporting relating to the YDOY;
 - b. the YDOY website; and
 - c. displays at the YDOY,and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the YDOY. By submitting their entry, each Entrant agrees to grant BIM a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, for the full period of any intellectual property rights in the YDOY entry and any accompanying materials, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sublicense the YDOY entry and any accompanying materials for such purpose and warrants that it has the absolute right to grant such licence to BIM.
11. Further to #10, each Entrant agrees that any personal information provided to BIM in connection with his or her entry may be held and used by BIM or its agents and suppliers to administer the YDOY.

Judging and prizes

12. The winner of each class will be announced at the ShowBoats Design Awards 2017 ceremony due to take place in February 2017. There will be no prior disclosure.
13. BIM has the right to determine the standard of an Award and to withhold an Award in any class if, in their view, entries are not of sufficient merit.
14. Each Entrant agrees that if they win the YDOY, BIM may use his or her name, image and town or country of residence to announce the winner of the YDOY and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.
15. BIM reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the YDOY where it becomes necessary to do so.

Limitation of liability

16. To the fullest extent allowed by law and insofar as it is reasonable to do so, entrants to the YDOY agree not to hold BIM liable for any damage or loss suffered or incurred in connection with entering the YDOY, including consequential (i.e. losses which are not incurred as a direct consequence of the event leading to any claim) or indirect losses or loss of profit, through entering the YDOY, attending the YDOY, alteration of the YDOY schedule, cancellation of the YDOY, or any error or omission on the part of BIM.



General

17. If there is any reason to believe that an Entrant has breached these terms and conditions, BIM may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude that Entrant from participating in the YDOY.
18. These Terms and Conditions, together with the material listed at #3 above, constitute the entire agreement of BIM and those participating in the YDOY. In submitting an entry and agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions, the parties have not relied on, and shall have no remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, warranty, understanding, promise or assurance (whether negligently or innocently made) of any person other than as expressly set out in these terms and conditions.
19. These terms and conditions are governed by and shall be interpreted in accordance with English law. Any disputes arising in relation to the interpretation of these terms and conditions or in relation to any agreement of which these terms and conditions form part, which cannot be settled amicably, shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
