

The America's Cup Superyacht Regatta (ACSYR) organisers, in conjunction with the safety officials of the America's Cup Event Authority, has established emergency procedures to provide help in the event of an on the water emergency, including injury requiring medical assistance. We also have emergency numbers should there be an accident or injury on shore.

1. Contact the Race Committee immediately on VHF 69 or VHF 63. If you are unable to contact the Race Committee, contact the Maritime Operations Centre Bermuda Radio on VHF Channel 16.
2. Identify your yacht, the nature of the emergency (type of injury, number of people injured), and your yacht's position.
3. The Race Committee or the Bermuda Radio will alert the ACSYR on water medical boats (which will also be monitoring VHF 69 and 63) and the appropriate personnel in Bermuda, and may direct you to another VHF channel or cell phone number for further communications.
4. Proceed at best speed to the emergency drop point at Ordinance Island in St George's Harbour or a designated rendezvous point as directed.
5. Depending on the nature and severity of the injury, should this be the emergency, medical boat personnel may come aboard your yacht to administer aid, evacuate the injured party and/or re-direct you to transfer of the injured person.
6. You are asked to cooperate fully with any Race Committee, local law enforcement and emergency personnel direction. Bermuda's emergency telephone numbers are listed below.
